Due to the Lincoln Center's fire codes all members of the audience must have a seat. Thanks for your enthusiasm!

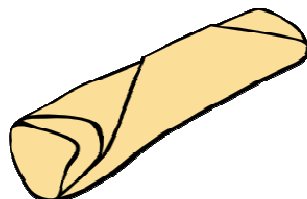

ASSESSMENTS & GALA

Congratulations to all who participated in Assessments & Gala!

Ballet students- Level 4-7 participated in annual assessment class in early April. Each level worked for 2-3 weeks to prepare and rehearse their barre work, and exercises for the centre and pointe, all of which reflected the progress that they've made throughout the year. Each level performed their class for a panel of CCBDC teachers, and in the last week of classes, each student will receive an assessment review sheet, con-

taining constructive comments and placement information for next Fall. Gala students- Ballet 1-3 were also watched at a selected class by a panel of CCDC instructors

The assessment & Gala process benefits everyone involved: it is an excellent opportunity for students to review their skills in a semi-formal setting, and to receive feedback about their work. It also gives the teaching staff a chance to get to know the dancers in ALL of the levels- especially the ones that they don't often teach. It also gives the instructors a chance to evaluate the

past year's progress for both the individuals and the class as a whole.

We want to express to EVERYONE who participated in Assessments and Gala, our gratitude and pride! Thanks to each of the dancers for your talent and dedication. Thanks to our parents for supporting your students love of dance! Thanks to all of the office staff, instructors and Board of Directors members who helped make the process possible. When you arrive for DRESS REHEARSAL go to the following location:

Arrive at backstage door, check in and then proceed to theatre. Parents please stay with child while they rehearse. We will do our best to stay on schedule, so your time in the theatre should be short. If your student is in multiple classes arrive to pick them up at the end of their last scheduled time. Please check out at the back stage door.

When you arrive for Performances go to the following location:

Creative Movement, CB&T 1-3, Boys Dance

Arrive at the front doors of the Columbine Room at the Lincoln Center and check in with the volunteer. Parents can pick up their child at the same door at intermission or at the end of the show. All children picked up at intermission will need a ticket for the rest of the show.

Ballet 1, 2, 3, Jazz 1 & 2, Hip 1, 2, 3, Tap 1/2, Modern 1 & 2, Lyrical 1

Arrive at the back stage door for check-in and go to the Columbine room. Parents can pick up their child at same door at intermission or end of the show. All children picked up at intermission will need a ticket for the rest of the show.

Ballet 4, 5, 6 & 7, Company, Jazz 3 & 4, Tap 3, Adv. Mod., Lyrical 2 & 3, & all other adult dancers

Arrive at the back stage door for check-in and go downstairs to the dressing rooms. All students checking out at intermission will need a ticket for the rest of the show. *Water will be available in the Columbine Room, food will not be provided. Ample time is provided for students to leave between rehearsal and the show to rest and eat.

We will need volunteers to help out with the Boutique on May 22 & 23.. We will need 4-5 people each day to help at the Boutique table at the Lincoln Center. If you are interested in helping with any of these items please see the office or sign up on the front board.
