

Hair – Basic Ballet Bun

Before you begin:

You will need to purchase the appropriate brushes, bobby pins, hair bands, clips, hair net and gel and hair spray.

- Bobby Pins, Clips and Hair Bands should match hair color and should NOT have metal or shiny parts.
- Hair net should also match hair color. These tear easily, so have extras on hand.
- You will need a gel or pomade...something to wet the hair and weight it down before putting it up.
- A STRONG hair spray. Aqua Net is really the best.
- You can also find much of what you need at a local drug store.
- Have a standard comb and brush.

1) Wet Hair & Brush

- Clean hair is not always the best for styling, but make sure it's well brushed.

2) Apply Gel

- Gel, pomade frizz tamer, anything that you can brush thru as you put in a pony tail, but will keep it smooth and neat.

3) Pony Tail

- Use a hair band (or two) to keep the hair secure in a pony tail
- Place ponytail at the middle back of the head, directly behind the ears and above the ears.

4) Comb & Brush

- Use a comb to smooth out the hair on the head, going into the ponytail.
- Brush thru the ponytail.

5) Twist or Braid

- Twist or Braid the pony tail

6) Bun

- Continue twisting the ponytail and wrap it in a spiral.

7) Bobby Pin

- Pin around the edges of the bun
- Be sure to grab hair from the bun and the head each time.
- Slide the pin in at an angle for the best hold.

8) Hair Net

- Wrap hair net around the completed bun.

9) Hair Spray

- Spray the entire thing.
- Pay special attention to wispsies around the hairline! (Use flat clips that match the color of your hair to secure especially difficult wispsies)
- Have child close eyes, and protect face.
